From 3 – 10 October, the Church in Australia will commence its fifth Plenary Council – the first in 84 years. 279 members will begin a process of dialogue focusing on 6 themes that were developed from the responses of over 220,000 people

Migrant and Refugee Sunday 26 September 2021 Towards An Ever Wider “We”

In Pope Francis’ introduction to the 107th World Day of Migrant and Refugees, he references the Encyclical *Fratelli Tutti*, and his concern and hope that, “Once this health crisis passes, our worst response would be to plunge even more deeply into feverish consumerism and new forms of egotistic self-preservation. God willing, after all this, we will think no longer in terms of ‘them’ and ‘those’, but only ‘us’” (No. 35).”

For this reason, Pope Francis wished to devote the Message for this year’s World Day of Migrants and Refugees to the theme, *Towards An Ever Wider “We”*.
