#### REFLECTION

On the 5th Sunday of Lent the Gospel passage shows us two kinds of sinners. First there is the woman who was caught in the act of adultery, a serious matter. But the Scribes and Pharisees are also sinners, totally lacking in the compassion which God expects of his followers: "Be merciful, as your Father in heaven is merciful." The Scribes and Pharisees are proud and arrogant, giving themselves the prerogative to sit in judgment on others. They do not know how to love, to forgive - only how to keep the Law. But how many of us would have acted differently in this case?




