12 June 2022

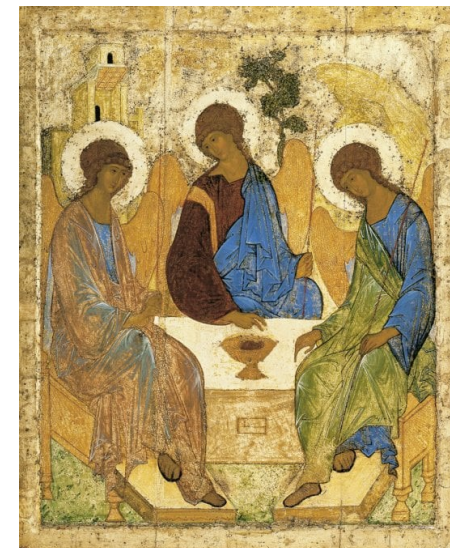


### Reflection from Father Henry

*The readings for The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity for Year C invite us to live in the light of God's truth. In the first reading we hear of the eternal nature of God. The psalm praises God for the wonders of his creation and his care for us. In the second reading Paul reminds us that faith brings us hope. In the gospel Jesus tells us that all that is the Father's is also his and he promises us the Spirit of truth.*

*As we draw closer to God and the mystery of the Trinity, we learn about God's love. God has lavished us with love in the persons of the Son and the Spirit, who in turn nurture in us the desire to do the same. When we open ourselves to be filled with an awareness of the divine life within us, we participate in the endless love that leads to eternal life. 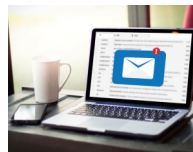

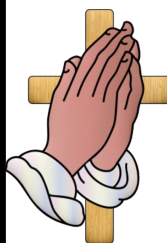
### St Vincent De Paul Society (SVDP) Winter Appeal: 18/19 June 2022
