The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), Year C 18 and 19 June 2022

Reflection from Father Henry

The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ is in accordance with the command of Jesus to us, to celebrate as a community his memory, the last meal, where he gave us the Holy Eucharist. During the last supper Jesus taught his followers the manner in which the Sacrament of the Eucharist should be celebrated. He also told them that he would be physically present in the Holy Eucharist and will be with them till the end of times.

Jesus uses a symbol of a meal to make us realise his presence. Every meal has its social dimension. Each and every celebration of ours, religious or secular, ends with a meal. A meal unites people, holds the family together and builds a community. Jesus uses this simple celebration of a meal to give us his closeness to us. It is build up on an idea of a family where everyone shares the common food and all are equal.

As we celebrate the Holy Eucharist let us be thankful to Jesus for His Body and Blood that assures us of our salvation. And let us also remember that each time we receive the Eucharist, it not only feeds us spiritually but also transforms us in his likeness. Let us remember it this weekend in a very practical way by helping the poor through the St Vincent de Paul winter appeal this weekend.


