Gospel Acclamation:


Alleluia, alleluia! Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Alleluia!

Reflection from Father Henry

Pentecost is the feast of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is the day when we remember the birth of the Church as we know it. For once the Holy Spirit was poured out on the Church, she began to carry out her mission. The Church's mission is simple: the Church is called to carry out the very mission of Christ. Just as Christ was anointed priest,

prophet, and king, so the Church is called to teach, lead, and sanctify. The Holy Spirit gives the Church the power to act in the person of Christ for the salvation of the world.

Pentecost is the birthday of the Church, because without the Holy Spirit there would be no Church, and there would be no Mass. It is the Spirit that brings us together today, it is the Spirit that breathed into the authors of the Sacred Scripture we read together at Mass, it is by the Power of the Holy Spirit that bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ, it is the Spirit that fills us here at Holy Mass.

But participating in the celebration of the Mass on Sunday is not what makes makes us a Church. It is what happens after Mass that makes us a Church. Just like

those first disciples, when we leave this Holy Mass we are empowered by God to carry forth the Good News to the entire world.

It is the Holy Spirit that empowers the Church to carry on the mission of Christ. It was the Spirit that moved in the hearts of the apostles to preach the good news. The same Holy Spirit is alive and with us today, it is this spirit that allows us to fulfil our mission as well.
