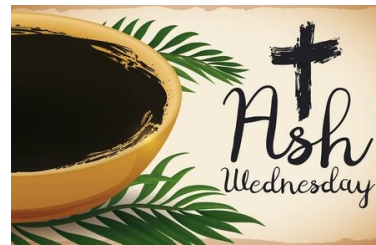

WORD OF GOD SUNDAY

In September 2019, Pope Francis instituted the celebration of Word of God Sunday when issuing the apostolic letter *Aperuit Illis* (External site). The letter encouraged the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God.

The Catholic Church in Australia celebrates Word of God Sunday on the first Sunday in February each year -- February 5 in 2023. Many countries celebrate the occasion on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time.

A number of resources have been developed to help individuals, families, parishes, schools and other ministries commemorate Word of God Sunday. Among ways Catholics and Catholic communities are being encouraged to mark the day are a special display of Sacred Scripture or the Book of the Gospels, the establishment of Bible study groups or the adoption of lectio divina, a common practice of reflection on Scripture.

Word of God Sunday, Year A

5 February 2023

SUNDAY REFLECTION

The theme that runs through the Scripture readings this Word of God Sunday is clearly that of “light”. We can see it in the First Reading (“then will your light shine like the dawn”), in the opening verse of the Responsorial Psalm and (with reference to Christ) in the Gospel Acclamation verse (“I am the Light of the world”), all building up the climactic statement in the Gospel: “You are the light of the world”. Only the Second Reading (1 Cor 2:1-5) stands apart.

The community of disciples is not just to be something for itself. In continuity with the vocation of Israel, the Church has the vocation both to preserve (“salt”) and to model (“light”) something for the rest of the world.

To appreciate what Jesus says about salt, we have to recall the role this item played in food preservation before refrigeration. Salt can hardly lose its taste but it may be so mixed with other elements as to become impure and so good only for salting the path outside the house, where people will trample it underfoot. Disciples who fall away from their vocation may face a similar fate.


Our readings this Sunday challenge us, not only as individuals but as parish and other communities, to reflect upon our vocation to be, according to the Second Vatican Council’s description of the Church, “the Light of the Nations” (Lumen Gentium), “salt of the earth”.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMS 2023

Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

If your child is in Year 3 or above, has been Baptised, they are eligible to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in our parish.

The Sacrament of First Reconciliation will be held on Friday 24th March 2023 at 6pm.

Sacrament preparation will be held at 6.30pm on 27th February, 6th, 13th, 20th March.

The Sacrament of First Holy Communion will be held on Sunday 18th June 2023.

Sacrament preparation will be held at 6.30pm on 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th May, 5th June.

Sacraments of Confirmation

If your child is in Year 6 or above, has been Baptised and has received the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, they are eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be held on Sunday 12th November 2023.

Sacrament preparation will be held at 6.30pm on 9th, 16th, 23rd October, 6th November.
