## SUNDAY REFLECTION

The Gospel reading for the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter takes us back to the days when Jesus was still physically present with the disciples. When Philip says to Jesus, "Show us the One who sent you, show us God," Jesus answers in the words of John the Evangelist: "I am in God and God is in me."

John's Gospel comes from a community that for many years had pondered the reality of Jesus in their lives. They had come to believe that somehow Jesus was in their midst and in him God's fullness dwelt. They had found Jesus to be *the way* for them. His care for others, his concern for those who are poor, his regard for "little ones," all these teachings of Jesus had permeated their lives with one another. Each of them could be as Jesus to the neigh-

bour. They could be in God and God in them. We are also called to this way of being.

So when we say to Jesus, "Show us God," the answer may come in the form of the next person we meet who needs something from us. A smile or a word or a listening ear - or whatever it may be. The answer may be a request to do something for the Community.
