REFLECTION

The readings for this Sunday are a call to trust in God. Although our circumstances can be unsettling or frightening, God is always caring for us. In the first reading Jeremiah trusts in the Lord even though he is being plotted against. The psalm expresses hope that God will hear our prayers in times of distress. The second reading reminds us that Jesus rescued us even though we are sinners.



In the gospel reading Jesus tells us "Fear no one" and that we are loved and cared for by God. Jesus encourages His disciples to fearlessly proclaim His teach-

ings, assuring them that whatever is hidden will be revealed and their actions will be brought to light. He emphasizes that they should not fear those who can harm the body, but rather fear God who holds ultimate authority over both body and soul, and promises that those who acknowledge Him before others will be acknowledged by Him in return. This theme encourages believers to overcome fear and rely on the courage that comes from faith in God. The Gospel also emphasises the value that God places on each individual. Jesus affirms that God's care extends even to the smallest details of His creation. This theme reminds us of our worth in God's eyes and reassures us of His intimate knowledge and care for us.
