REFLECTION

The Gospel of Matthew for the 18th Sunday of Ordinary time gives us again a small understanding about the Kingdom of Heaven. It is like a wonderful gift of love for all others and should overcome in us all the desire to have things just for myself or for my loved ones. Rather, the Kingdom of Heaven pushes us to seek all that is good for the good of all.

In the first reading King Solomon asks for wisdom to be able to guide the people of his

kingdom. The surprise is that King Solomon does not ask for strength, nor for riches, nor for a good life for himself, nor for triumph over his enemies. Instead, King Solomon seeks wisdom to serve the people.

This brings us back to the Gospel for this Sunday. God brings about His Kingdom and God will take out of His Kingdom all that does not belong to His Kingdom. You and I should not recognize that preparation is necessary so that we can be with God completely and always. Let us pray for the Kingdom of God! Once we see the immense value and joy of the Kingdom, it is all we shall want.
