



The Church in Australia celebrates the Sunday of the Word of God on the first Sunday in February – February 4 in 2024. Pope Francis established the day, which is devoted to “the celebration, study and dissemination” of the Word of God.



The readings for Word of God Sunday 2024 take seriously the pain and grief of the broken-hearted, and the responsibility of Christians to actively respond in service. For those caught in situations and cycles of despair and hopelessness, there can seem no end in sight and no respite. In the First Reading from Job, we are reminded that this can be the reality of existence for people experiencing physical sickness and mental ill-health, or those trapped in cycles of war, exploitation, or abuse.

St Paul in the second reading calls on us to accept the life of freedom in discipleship God offers that meets us in any current reality with blessing. Christians are witnesses to active hope. The Good News visibly renews life and brings new possibilities, even when it may seem that there is no way forward.

In the Gospel Jesus reaches out to Peter's mother-in-law in her distress, drawing close and taking her by the hand with no delay. He heals her and she immediately begins to serve others.

God heals the broken-hearted and sends us as disciples to do likewise. How will you bring healing to others this week?

Children of the Parish are invited to participate in Children's Liturgy of the Word which is held every Second and Fourth Sunday of the month during the 9am Mass.

During the Mass, Father calls the children forward after the Introductory Rites and they follow their adult catechists to their worship space where they take part in the Sunday Scripture at an age appropriate level with terminology that will assist the children to understand and appreciate the Gospel message. The children return to Mass to sit with their families after the General Intercessions to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMS 2024

Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

If your child is in Year 3 or above, and has been Baptised, they are eligible to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in our parish.

The Sacrament of First Reconciliation will be held on Friday, 22nd March 2024.

The Sacrament of First Holy Communion will be held on Sunday, 2nd June 2024.

Sacraments of Confirmation

If your child is in Year 6 or above, has been Baptised and has received the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, they are eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be held on Sunday, 29th September 2024.
