HAPPY FATHER'S DAY

Today we celebrate Father's Day. It is a day for people to show their appreciation for fathers and father figures, including stepfathers, grandfathers, fathers-in-law, guardians and Priests, Brothers and other clergy in our Church.

We pray for all fathers and for all special men in our lives. We also pray and remember those fathers and father figures who are no longer with us. May God bless you all.

The 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B readings remind us of the importance of obeying God's laws, acting on His Word, and maintaining our faith from within.

In the gospel Jesus challenges the religious structures and their leaders who are obsessed with exterior

The Pharisees were focused on external rituals, like washing hands, rather than the heart. Jesus explained that true purity comes from within. He shows that the law is meant to purify our hearts and help us live in God's presence. Israel was to be an example to other nations, and we are called to be doers of the Word, living justly and caring for others. We must follow the law sincerely, not just

There may be a temptation for us to see in this Gospel a simple criticism by Jesus of external observances of the Law, or of external observances of the faith, attendance at Mass, praying the Angelus or the rosary, attending novenas. Jesus' challenge is much wider than this – it speaks to all who try to be faithful to God

The best way to be faithful to God's Word is to allow our hearts to be transformed by it. So, rather than pay excessive attention to the letters of the law and physical purity, we must heed Paul's advice: "Let vour hearts be inwardly transformed, so that you will know the will of God." (Rom 12, 2). God's will is his law. It must motivate us to love others, and to avoid evil. It must evoke true repentance and a sincere will to forgive others. It must keep us firm in faith. Above all, it must move us pursue only


