Reflection

In today's gospel passage from Mark, Jesus teaches us what it means to be truly great. He doesn't say that we shouldn't seek greatness, or try to be the best person we can be. But he turns the common understanding of greatness on its head: 'If anyone wants to be first, he must make himself last of all and servant of all' (Mk 9:35). This teaching doesn't sit easily with us. It's not the way the world thinks or works. The instruction of Jesus has nothing to do with human wisdom. It makes sense only from the perspective of God's way of judging persons and situations, that is, from the perspective of the Kingdom of God.

Jesus illustrates his teaching about greatness by calling a small child to himself, placing this child in front of them and then identifying himself with those whom the child represents: 'Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me' (Mk 9:37).

The values of the kingdom are most clearly manifest in children who are small, vulnerable, trusting and defenceless. When we welcome them and learn from them, and from all the little ones of our world; when we enter the world they inhabit, letting go of our desire to be big and important, we become servants and agents of God's kingdom. And thus we become great in God's eyes. Such service is not drudgery or slavery, but liberating and joyful, for it makes us children of the kingdom.
