

149th SVD Foundation Day

On 8th September 1875, St. Arnold Janssen opened a Mission House in Steyl, Holland in order to train priests and seminarians to become foreign missionaries particularly for China. It is in the founding of this simple house just across the border from Germany that it would later become known as the founding of the Society of the Divine Word (SVD), a religious congregation of priests and Brothers dedicated to spreading the Word of God throughout the world. Today, there are about 6,000 Divine Word Missionary priests, lay brothers and seminarians working in more than seventy countries all over the world. Here in Australia province, we're working in the states of New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, Western Australia and the Northern Territory.



We're also working in New Zealand, Thailand and Myanmar as part of the province. As we celebrate our 149th foundation day, we continue to pray for more vocations as the harvest is plenty, but the labourers are always few.

Unlike the founding day of the Society of the Divine Word, (SVD) we do not know the actual date on which the Blessed Virgin Mary was born. Despite the countless apparitions of Mary around the world over the centuries, she has never revealed this little piece of information to us. However, the Church has chosen a particular day in the liturgical calendar in order to celebrate Mary's birthday, just as the Church has done the same with the birthdays of John the Baptist and Jesus Christ.
