World Mission Sunday

Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B

Reflection

The readings of this Sunday present the core missionary character of Jesus. He is that servant of Yahweh who voluntarily accepted the way of suffering and shame for the good of his brothers. Through his dialogue with his disciples, Jesus opens their eyes to the realities ahead of them. By asking them: "Can you drink the cup that I must drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I must be baptized." Jesus reminds them and us of the challenges ahead.

Mission is service and sacrifice rendered in love for the salvation of all nations. This love comes with patience and docility to the will of God. It begins by transforming us into a great instrument for the salvation of others. So, today Christ teaches us that to be great is to be ready to serve and to make sacrifice for others.

Today, the voice of salvation continues to call us to be more faithful to God's mission. It reminds us of the great challenges before us today. This includes our changing cultures, societies and lifestyle that must be urgently evangelized and redeemed.

The good news is that we can overcome these challenges through the spirit of sacrifice and love. So, in the midst of all these challenges, we must find consolation in these words from the letter to the Hebrews: "Let us be confident, then in approaching the throne of grace, that we shall find mercy and grace when we are in need of help."

This grace is sufficient for us to accomplish God's mission. Therefore, with the psalmist, let us pray: "Lord, let your love be upon us, as we place our trust in you."


